Welcome! Thank you for registering for the 2020 COVID Edition of the Mary and Anna Memorial Ride held at the Outback Station!

The Outback Station is located in Lake County, Oregon. Lake County is currently in Phase 2 of Oregon's Reopening Program. We will be following the guidelines set forth by Lake County and Oregon's governor. Because the Mary and Anna Memorial Rides qualify as an "Outdoor Event", we are limited to 250 people at our venue, provided outdoor social distancing rules can be followed. We will have Stewards both days this year. One of the Steward's jobs will be to make sure our Covid Guidelines are being followed. This is for the safety of all our riders, crews, volunteers and veterinarians.

In order to receive our sanctioning by AERC and our endorsement by EDRA, we had to develop a Covid Plan that followed their guidelines. Please read the guidelines and be prepared to follow them as closely as possible.
